Reporting – The Program Committee reports to the Board.

Meeting schedule – The committee meets approximately five times each year, with special meetings convened as required.

Membership – The committee comprises the CAT director and curator, Board representation and three external members who provide artistic or curatorial expertise. The curatorial mentorship role is also engaged with the committee. Appointed external positions are offered for 3-year terms.

Selection – To broaden the scope of representation on the committee, we are now making changes to how appointments are made. External members will be appointed through a process alternating between invitation and a call-out for expressions of interest. The CAT Board oversees approval of appointments to these positions.

Eligibility – Artists and industry peers from all career-stages are eligible to apply. We welcome interest from professional artists from all backgrounds, abilities and identities.

- · artistic experience relevant to the role
- · knowledge of the national contemporary art sector
- · engagement with contemporary culture
