

Contemporary Art Tasmania Studio Applications

Two non-residential studios are available by application on an annual basis. The studios are located at 27 Tasma St, North Hobart, above Contemporary Art Tasmania's offices.

Eligibility

To be eligible you must:

- Be an active practicing artist or practitioner in a related field
- Not be enrolled in tertiary study during the studio placement
- Be over 18 years of age
- Live in Tasmania

Past unsuccessful applicants may re-apply. Practices that involve heavy equipment, significant noise, dust, harsh chemicals and heavy metals are not suitable for these spaces.

Obligations

- No rent or utility bills are associated with the studios, however a \$300 deposit is required, fully refundable on vacating the studio
- Studio residents must have public liability insurance
- Successful applicants to become CAT members, a \$20 yearly fee

Accessibility

- CAT studios can only be accessed by stairs, and are on the first floor of the building.
- There is 24 hour access, each studio is lockable and has an alarm system
- Studios have a window, a heater and wifi

Applications

Studio applications are assessed by the Contemporary Art Tasmania Programming Committee against the following criteria:

- Clarity and relevance of personal and professional objectives for the year ahead
- Extent to which the award of a studio would clearly contribute to the applicant's professional development
- Demonstrated commitment to pursuing a professional practice in the arts

To apply for one of the two annual studio residencies

- A one page pdf outlining your vision for the residency and indicating how a studio would assist your development
- One page CV (pdf)
- Support material:
 - A single pdf of no more than 12 images; OR
 - A link to website, video, performance or sound works of no more than 5 minutes duration
- All support material must be clearly labeled with the artists name, work title, date and details
